\$70,336

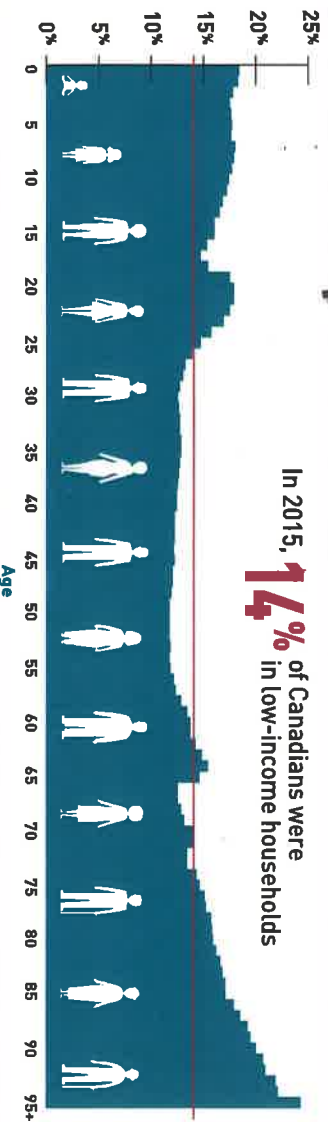
The **Northwest Territories** had the highest median household income, while the **Maritime Provinces** and **Quebec** had the lowest



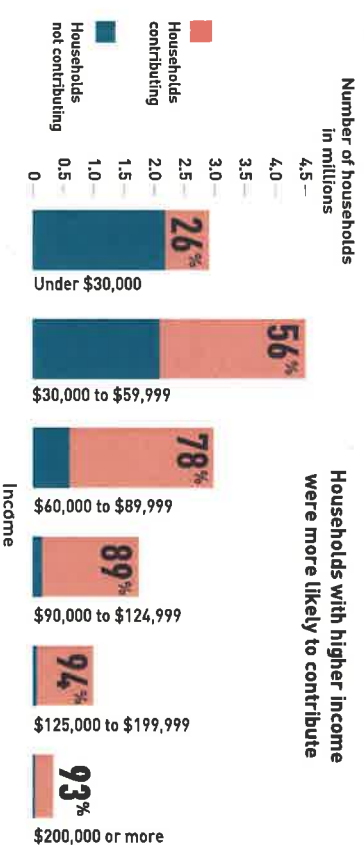

65% of households contributed to an RRSP, RPP or TFSA*

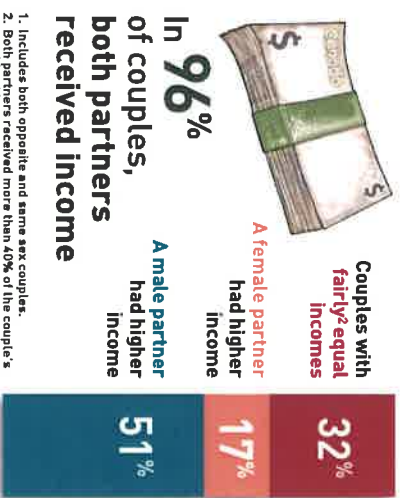
