What is the Immigrant Advisory Table?

The TCLIP Immigrant Advisory Table (IAT) consists of individuals who represent a range of countries of origin, lengths of time in Canada, occupational backgrounds, ages and gender and various other forms of diversity. Members will have experience, knowledge, abilities, or skills related to Immigrant settlement and integration in the Tri-Cities and are non-partisan.

What is the TCLIP ?

The Tri-Cities Local Immigration Partnership's (TCLIP) mandate is to foster a more welcoming and inclusive community and improve the integration & inclusion of newcomers.

What would be my roles and responsibilities?

- Review the TCLIP Strategic Plan to ensure it reflects immigrant and newcomer needs and priorities;
- Provide input to the TCLIP and its work by participating in IAT, Council and working group meetings;
- Act as a resource for Tri-Cities community service providers;
- Help lead or co-lead the implementation of strategic priorities in collaboration with the TCLIP members;
- Reach out to ethno-specific communities to share TCLIP information and encourage participation in its work.
- Commit to participating in monthly meetings with other advisors and partners.
